I found support in my friends who had singletons, but it was so different having TWO at the same time, and I compared many many things with my friends and their children. Although their support was needed, I could never quite get them to understand what exactly I was feeling, dealing with, etc.

When we received orders to move to San Antonio, I was VERY excited and started researching for a mom's group as soon as possible. One week after moving in, we attended our first SAAMOM baby playdate. I was adamant to find friends and a support system unlike what I had had (which was pretty awesome considering). I found close friends right away, and have loved every minute of the past three years being a member of this group! Although I have an outgoing personality, I realize that the more I invest in this group, the more I will gain from it. SAAMOM has been my rock, my confidant, my support, my joy, my laughter, and my strength.

Uniquely Perfect



Hi my name is Cynthia and I am a mother to 4 children. Two girls , a miscarriage and then blessed with identical twins that are now 22 months. The Twins were a BIG surprise. I PPROM twin B (in utero) at 28 0/7. Was admitted given Magnesium since I had just turned 28 weeks I was in a window that if given it could decrease chances of CP . I was also given betamethasone to help their premature lungs. I stayed in- patient for 6 days before they decided on an emergent C-section for a non- reassuring fetal strip on twin B (in utero). I still remember the Dr.'s words. " I want to deliver 2 live babies we need to go now". Not what an Obstetric Nurse wants to hear. I had been scanned every two weeks since I was 18 weeks for TTS (Twin to Twin Syndrome) and never any sign instead I had Twin to Twin Anemia Polycythemia . Twin A "Jacob" 2# 7 oz. (B in utero)(Anemia) was taken to the other OR room and all I remembered was there was no cry from baby A and then there came baby B "John" 2 # 11 oz. (A in utero) (Polycythemia) crying and he was born in his sac (it's supposedly a good omen). Jacob needed a blood transfusion and medications to increase his blood pressure , he fought to survive. They had him intubated using a high vent.

Meeting these two little boys for the first time was so emotional , I kept apologizing that I was not able to keep them in my belly longer so they would not have had to experience the stress of all these tubes. We had routine scans and everything was going so well then........ on Jacob's 4th head ultrasound they found some changes. I still remember being called into a little room and she sat me down and gave me a box of tissues. Jacob was diagnosed with PVL (Periventricular leukomalacia is a condition that affects the white matter in the brain which causes motor control problems, developmental delays and epilepsy) all I heard from this is he may have Cerebral Palsy which means he may have difficulty with fine and gross motor skills. This was surely the saddest day of my life. Why? Because I want him feel no different that his twin brother and not struggle to accomplish things that are suppose to be simple. The unknown as well as not having control of all this has been the hardest to deal with.

He is now 22 months corrected 19 months and has received Botox to his hamstrings because he has Diplegia Spasticity of his legs and Hypotonia of his trunk . He is mobile he gets around by commando crawling and rolling and has finally pulled himself up to kneel. When he says Mamma and smiles that alone is rewarding. He gets PT 2x week, OT x2 week, Speech 1x week and a teacher who plays and sings songs with him 1 x week. This journey not alone has made me appreciative of all the small things but his sisters are so excited when he does new things or says new words and they both love to help him and do the exercise PT shows us . His twin brother runs all over the place. What has been so amazing is the support I have received from the PVL group and knowing that anything is possible. They are only doctors , they are not GOD and I am lucky to have him alive . He is who he is meant to be.


